pre	before	<u>p</u> rehistoric	Examples could include... preview, prefix, preschool
over	too much	<u>o</u> vercook	Examples could include... overlook, overuse, overload
un	not	<u>u</u> nhappy	Examples could include... unfriendly, unhelpful, unrealistic
