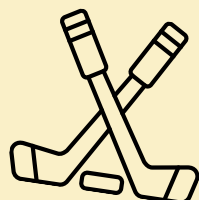

fraction	A number that represents part of a whole
whole	All of something: a whole shape, a whole pizza
numerator	Top number in a fraction. Shows how many parts we have
denominator	Bottom number in a fraction. Shows how many equal parts in the whole
unit fraction	A fraction with a numerator of 1
non-unit fraction	A fraction with a numerator that is not equal to 1
equivalent fraction	Fractions have the same value, even though they may look different

renewable energy	energy made from resources that nature will replace, like wind, water and sunshine.
urbanisation	is the movement of people (population) into cities and away from rural areas.
evaporation	When water turns into water vapour.
condenses	When water vapour cools and turns back into water.
flood	a high-water event in which water overflows its banks onto normally dry land.
drought	Wherever there is a shortage of rain over a long period of time.
infiltration	When water soaks or filters into the soil.
runoff	The draining away of water from a surface of an area of land.
precipitation	Any liquid or frozen water that falls back to Earth.
reservoir	A man-made storage area for water.
water vapour	When water turns into gas-like.

Angles People from Germany who invaded Britain around AD 410.

Anglo-Saxon The name given to the people who travelled from Germany and South Denmark and settled in Britain around AD 410.

archaeologist Someone who studies the past by exploring old remains.

Viking The name given to the highly skilled warriors, seafarers and farmers from Norway, Denmark, Sweden and Iceland.

Danelaw An agreement that allowed the Vikings to live in England alongside the Anglo Saxons.

Christianity The religion based on the teachings of Jesus Christ.

invasion To try to take over a place by force.

Jutes People from the Jutland peninsula (Germany and Southern Denmark) who invaded Britain around AD 410.

SETPS Set the pen thickness

PU Lift the pen up off the screen.
