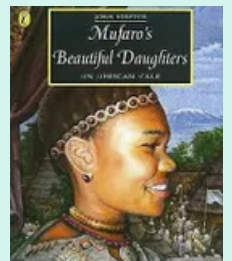

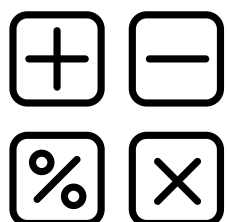

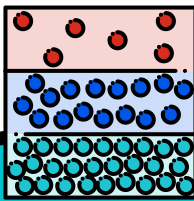

Computing Spreadsheets

Key Vocabulary

cell	A box on a spreadsheet where you can enter information in the form of text, numbers or formulas .
chart	A graph or diagram that shows data and makes it easier to understand.
column	A range of vertical cells identified by a letter.
formula	A calculation using the data from two or more cells .
function	A formula that has been built into a spreadsheet program and is used to simplify and shorten calculations.
range	A number of cells across a column , row or both.
row	A range of horizontal cells identified by a number.
worksheet	A named set of rows and columns . There can be more than one worksheet in a spreadsheet workbook.
