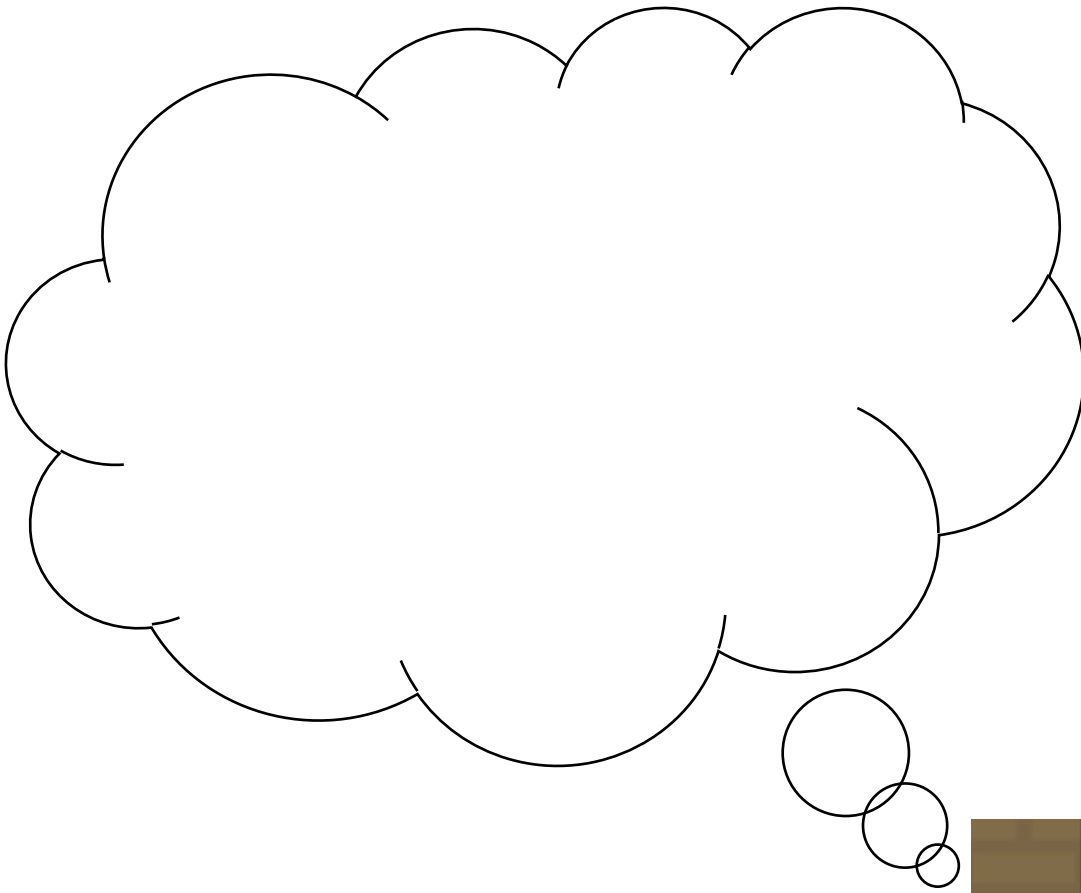


What was Daisy thinking?
