

The Meet and Greet Song:

Adult Guidance

You can teach this lovely little song to your class in any number of ways. Each verse builds on the ones before, with the new words and tune highlighted and the previous ones sung quietly in the background.

Start by playing just the backing track and discuss what the music makes them feel / think of. Whether you get any 'French' responses may depend on whether they have any prior experience of France. However, simply 'getting into' the music is a good beginning.

Break it down and learn each verse separately. You may want to use one verse for a single lesson delivering that theme, following with another lesson on the next topic. Alternatively, learn the whole thing in one go, just for fun!

Why not use it as music for a dance PE lesson? They'll be floating around the room as if they're on 'Strictly Come Dancing' and practising their French at the same time!
