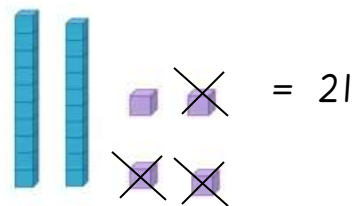


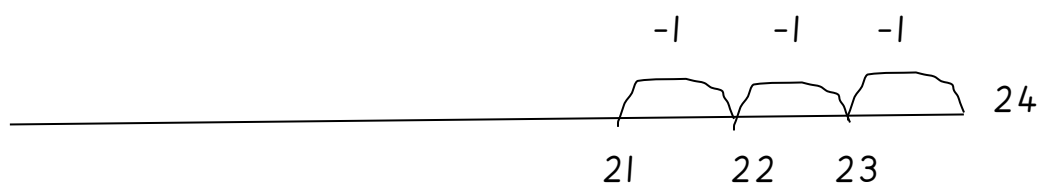
21.4.20 LO To subtract a one-digit number from a two-digit number.

You could try to work these out in your head. Just look at the ones, the tens won't change. You have enough ones in the two-digit number to subtract the one-digit number.

If you are struggling, draw a picture eg $24 - 3$



or, use a number line.
