### Week 1

#### **Flags of the World!**

1. Choose 5 countries
2. Draw the flag of each country
3. Underneath each flag write the name of the country and the language spoken
4. Which continent does it belong to?

### Week 2

#### **Sporty World!**

1. Choose a sport (the more unusual the better!)
2. Find out which country the sport originates from
3. Write a list of equipment and clothing needed
4. Write a brief description of the rules
5. Draw or print a picture

### Week 3

#### **Delicious World!**

1. Choose a recipe from your favourite country
2. Write an ingredient list
3. Get cooking!
4. Write simple step-by-step instructions
5. Don't forget to take a photo before you eat it!

### Week 4

#### **Navigate the World!**

1. Choose a city in a different country
2. Work out how to get there
3. Write down your route and your forms of transport
4. How many miles will you travel and how long will it take?
5. Design a postcard or poster to show off the city

### Week 5

#### **Animals of the World!**

1. Choose an animal from anywhere in the world
2. Do some research and write about the animal: Where does it live? What does it eat? What does it look like? Does it have any enemies? Is it endangered?
3. Draw or print a picture of your animal

### Week 6

#### **Amazing Natural World!**

1. Choose one of Earth's natural wonders – eg mountain, rainforest, ocean, glacier, desert, river, aurora borealis, volcano
2. Draw diagrams or make a collage from printed pictures
3. Write down at least 5 facts about this amazing natural wonder
