Week 1

Still Life!

1. On a table, arrange several objects you have collected from around your home – eg apple, shoe, jug, toy (themed or random)
2. Using any medium – pencil, pen, paint, chalk (it is up to you)...produce a picture of the objects you see before you
3. Display your picture!

Week 2

Sculpture!

1. Collect clean recycled materials (tubes, boxes, containers, lids etc) plus sticky tape/glue and decorative items

3. Now get creative!
4. Take a photo of your sculpture

Week 3

Painting Stones!

1. First find some flat smooth stones about the size of the palm of your hand
2. You will need felt tip pens or paints and a thin brush

4. See how creative you can be!

Week 4

Copy the Masters!

1. Do some research about famous artists
2. Decide on a piece of art you would like to copy
3. Using any medium – pencil paint, sculpture, chalk make your version of your chosen art work
4. Why not get family to join in and then exhibit your work!

Week 5

Printing project!

1. Take a look at <https://tinkerlab.com/printmaking-for-kids>
2. Hunt around the house for objects that would be good for printing
3. You will need paint for this project, any colours will do
4. Create your printed picture
5. Can members of your family work out what objects you used?

Week 6

Self Portrait!

2. Decide on which materials you are going to use
3. Find a comfy place to sit where you can look at your reflection in a mirror and create your portrait!
4. Display your work
