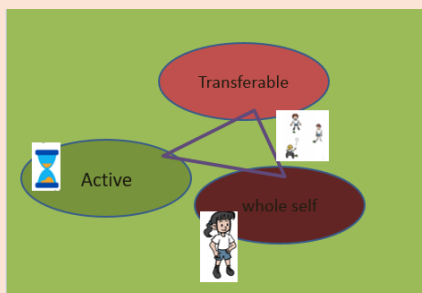
What are we working on this year?
