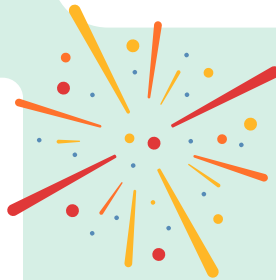


Interfaith week 2024
