Year 5 and Year 1

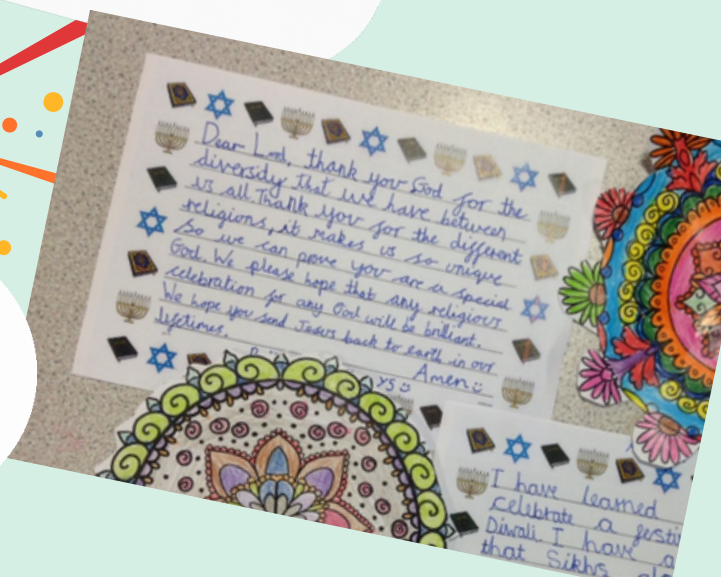
Diwali dance workshop- exploring the story of Lord Rama and Princess Sita

We had visits from Meols Cop and Christ the King students to teach us about all faiths and how they serve others. They gave us a lovely new book about world faiths.



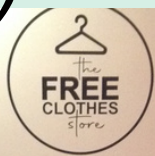
Year 3 and 4 went to the Southport mosque
