Access arrangements are available for children who need them, and these are put in place sensitively and routinely under the direction of our SENDCo to ensure that no child is disadvantaged by an additional need.

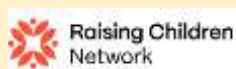
**Congratulation to this Year 4 Eco Warrior who has been litter picking and has earnt a wonderful Blue Peter Badge! We are very proud of her.**
