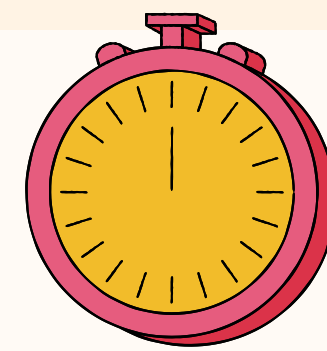


BRITISH SCIENCE WEEK 2026!

Year 1

Icey Islands

Year 1 investigated what happened to our 'icy' islands when the ice melted. Looking at the impact of climate change!

Year 4 were investigated the Science behind everyday food! They looked at how far food travels to their plates and then experimented making bread. They even got to taste them and compare the impact of ingredients!



Year 2

Year 2 students explored how birds build strong, safe, and comfortable nests, designing their own using twigs, grass, leaves, and feathers. They tested their creations against wind and rain, learning about teamwork, creativity, and scientific thinking

Year 6 looked at boats and what allows them to float. They then had a go at using different materials such as paper and tinfoil to design and make their own boat to keep a marble afloat!



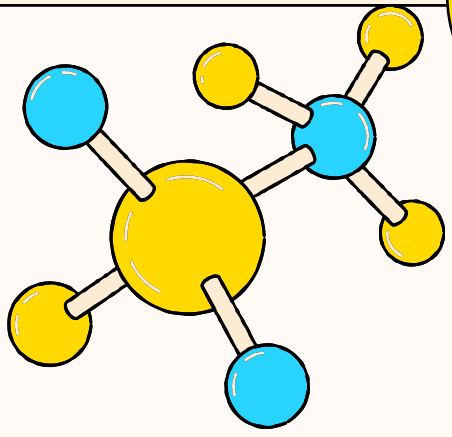
Reception

Reception had a go at matching pictures of animals and grouping them based off some characteristics.

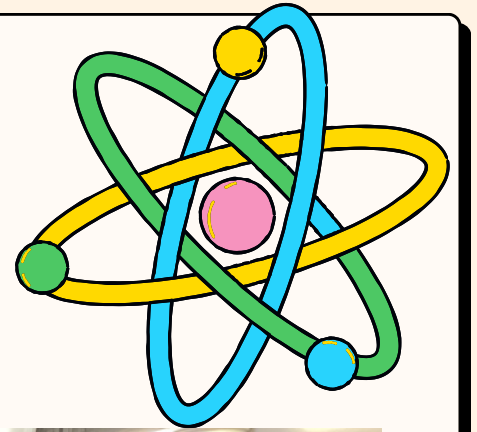


Well done to all the children this week on all the amazing science learning that has taken place, you and our amazing staff have truly brought science to life at St Philips! - Mr Highton
